


HOT OR NOT SCAVENGER HUNT



Instructions:

REGIONAL

Parents: Tell your child you are going to go on a scavenger hunt together. You will need tape and some cutouts of the hot and cool symbols on the next page. Go together but let your child lead on the hunt. When your child finds a cool item, allow him or her to tape the "cool" symbol to the item. When your child finds a hot or sometimes hot item, he or she should tell you and ask you to tape the "hot" symbol near the item. When all of the cutouts are gone, review the hot, sometimes hot, and cool items found in the home. When you find the other items, check them off the list!

Smoke Alarm Checklist:

Your child has been learning about smoke alarms.

Working smoke alarms save lives. That's right, having smoke alarms
in your home is very important. Smoke alarms let you know there is a fire.

Working smoke alarms also give you time to get outside and stay outside if there is a fire.

Follow the ster	ns below to check	the smoke alarms	in vour home.

Your child can help, too!

- **LOOK** around your home and make sure you have a smoke alarm on every level (including the basement) and inside every room where people sleep.
- PRESS the "Test" button on each smoke alarm. If the smoke alarm makes a "beep, beep, beep" sound, it is working. Make sure you test each smoke alarm every month.
- If the smoke alarm does not make a sound, **REPLACE** the battery or batteries. If it still doesn't work, replace the alarm.
- Ask your child to **FILL IN** the chart as you test the smoke alarms in your home.
